Hygiene concept for the Teufelstisch adventure park in Hinterweidenthal -

Corona Pandemic 2020

Due to the 10th Corona Control Ordinance of the State of Rhineland-Palatinate published on 19 June 2020, which comes into force on 24 June 2020, the Teufelstisch Adventure Park in Hinterweidenthal will be opened under the following conditions:

1. The applicable spacing and contact restrictions are ensured by the following measures:

- a. A maximum of 400 people may be in the park at any one time.
- b. The distance of at least 1.5 metres per person must be ensured by the visitors on their own responsibility. There is a main entrance area where the Guidance of coming and going persons is ensured by means of barriers and floor markings.

2. Organization of the operation:

- a. The giant slide and the corresponding staircase are closed and are cordoned off accordingly.
- b. The minigolf course is closed.
- c. The other entrances to the park as well as the entrance to the giant slide and the access to the stairs are closed and provided with barriers, so that only the entrance through the main entrance is possible.
- d. Picnic is not allowed.
- e. A pre-booking or registration (especially for groups, birthday parties, etc.) is not possible due to the current situation.
- f. The contact details of visitors are not recorded.
- g. The available seating can be adjusted accordingly, while observing the distance requirement can be used.

3. General rules of hygiene

- a. The use of the sanitary facilities is to be carried out in compliance with the necessary protective measures permissible. The contact surfaces in the area of the sanitary facilities are regularly disinfected and cleaned (approx. every 3 hours).

- b. Dispensers for hand disinfection are installed in the access area to the park. These are to be used by the visitors entering the park. Soap for hand cleaning is available in the sanitary areas.
- c. In order to remind and sensitize the visitors, signs are erected in the park in clearly visible places.

4. As a general rule:

- a. Access with dogs is not permitted.
- b. Persons with clear symptoms of a respiratory infection (cough, sniffles, etc.) are denied access to the park.
- c. Persons who are not prepared to comply with these rules will be denied access within the framework of the house rules, or they will have to leave the park.
- d. The opening hours are daily from 10.00 to 18.00 hours.
